RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Water Distribution Operator can expect to:

- Perform operation and repair maintenance on a variety of water distribution devices and lines. Maintain and monitor reservoirs including adjusting chlorine residuals. Investigate system problems throughout pressure zones. Monitor and diagnose water distribution systems.
- Perform system flushing, exercise valves, and maintain/repair or replace hydrants.
- Take special water samples and deliver to the lab.
- Maintain records and maps as required by state and federal regulations.
- Operate equipment including dump trucks, street cutting saw, jack hammer and trenching machine and other equipment as assigned. Inspect all equipment, attachments and tools for safety. Ensure job site utilities have been located prior to beginning work.
- Replace meters, meter boxes, verify pressure, develop and initiate leak detection strategies, operate correlation equipment.
- Set up safe work zones including traffic controls, shoring and confined space entry.
- Have the ability to perform critical infrastructure assessment and document using asset management system for future system master planning.
- Repair landscapes after utility repairs.
- Provide excellence in internal and external customer service.
- Support and respect diversity in the workplace.
- Assist in notifying citizens of scheduled projects.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills, Abilities:

• Oregon Water Distribution 1 Certification, or ability to obtain within 6 months of hiring. Oregon Water Distribution Certification 2 preferred. Must have or be able to obtain CDL within 6 months of employment.

- General building maintenance.
